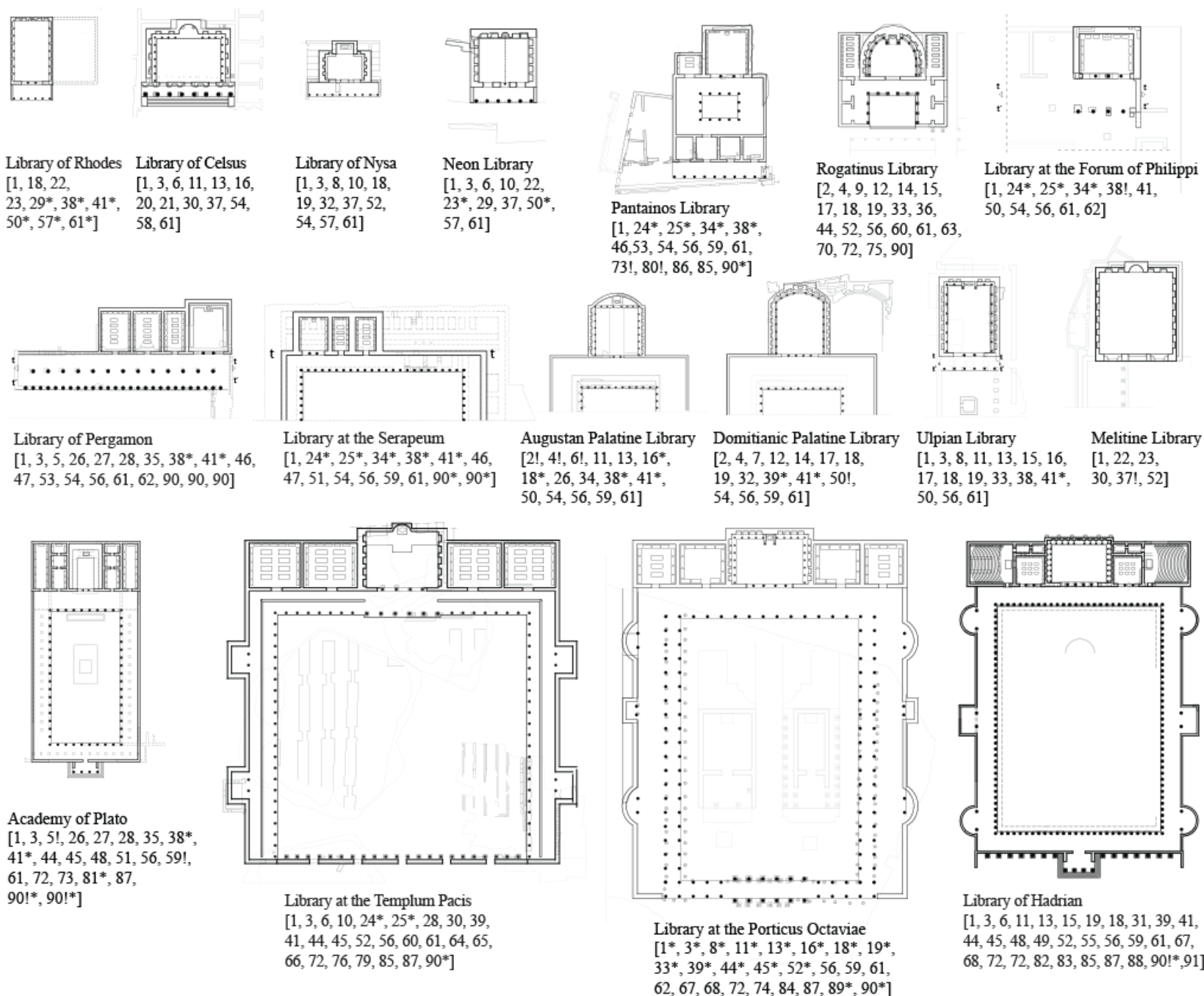


THE IMPERIAL ROMAN LIBRARY AS A MONUMENTAL CULTURAL CENTER: Possible Architectural Forms with Shape Grammars

Drawing on evidence on ancient testimonia and material evidence, the talk will reframe the ancient bibliotheca as a cultural center where works of art and manuscripts were inseparable, will discuss the design principles of libraries, and present a computational methodology to generate variant possible reconstructions of the main hall based on the design rules that encode these principles.
